GET TO KNOW



BACKGROUND:

Students enroll in the three-week summer program in fourth or fifth grade and continue every summer through their junior year in high school. Program graduates who qualify for admission to Regis University will be eligible to **receive a scholarship to Regis** that covers tuition and fees.



MISSION:

The Academy **helps at-risk youth** who have academic and leadership potential to **successfully graduate from high school and attend college.**
